Assesses the educational credentials of individuals who have been displaced as a result of adverse circumstances in their country and have limited proof of academic achievements

You May Be Eligible If:



You were educated in Afghanistan, Eritrea, Iraq, Syria, Turkey, Ukraine, or Venezuela



You completed high school or some college or university



You have your diploma and/or transcript



You live in the United States

Step 1 Find a Referral Partner

Step 2 Apply to the Program

- Connect with a referral organization to have your application submitted
- Sign in to your WES account to upload your documents and to follow the progress of your application



Step 3 Pursue Your Goals

- Contact your referral organization after receiving your credential evaluation report to discuss next steps
- Use your report to apply for education, licensure, or employment that matches your studies
